Then, when the police arrived at the shop, they found a monkey with the merchant's purse. So this was a great mistake...



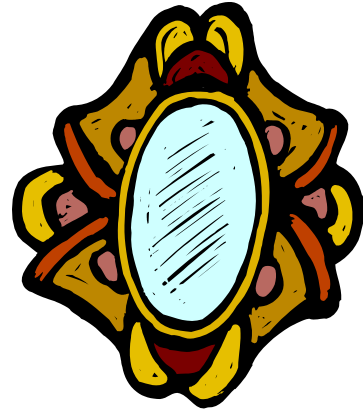
